STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The District does not provide bus service for students to and from school. Bus service is provided for most student activity trips.

Transportation to Activities

The purpose of busing for activities is to provide transportation for academic field trips in direct support of the curriculum and transportation for support of the co-curricular program (athletics, music, drama, etc.).

When it is more practical, as determined by the principal, students may be transported for activities in private vehicles owned by district employees or patrons. The expense reimbursed in such instances will not exceed the state approved mileage reimbursement rate.

The principals working under the supervision of the superintendent will be responsible for the day-to-day operation of transportation services for school activities.

Authorized school employees or volunteers who are properly licensed will operate vehicles owned by the District. These persons must meet all state requirements for licensing and requirements of the insurance carrier.

Transportation or Board and Room Allowance

The following elementary students who do not have access to bus service furnished by the school district to and from school are entitled to a transportation or board and room allowance:

Elementary students who attend an elementary school where they are assigned and the distance is in excess of five miles from the student's residence.

Students who are entitled to a transportation allowance but transportation is not practical, the Board shall pay room and board in lieu of transportation for those students who are boarded away from home to attend a district school.
