COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

Since the district schools belong to the patrons of the school district, the board will grant the use of school facilities for activities of a cultural, educational, civic, social, recreational, governmental, funerals/memorial services, and general political nature which are to be sponsored by responsible, recognized local persons, organizations, agencies, or institutions. However, these activities may not interfere with the conduct and best interest of the district or its programs.

The superintendent will have the authority to grant the use of school facilities with the exception of requests for conventions, special events not meeting the criteria above, and events sponsored by religious organizations that must be considered by the board.

Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, 4-H, AAU, and similar recognized youth groups are exempt from paying fees but must observe all other regulations.

Rental fees for games and tournaments will be negotiated by the administration. Rental fees for conventions and special events requiring board approval will be set on an individual basis by the board.

The superintendent may allow individuals from the community to utilize the districts athletic facilities for recreational purposes at no charge.

All individuals or organizations wishing to use school facilities will sign a contract with the district designating a specific individual as being in charge of opening, closing, and supervising the facility. A list of rules and/or expectations will be given to the individual who signs the contract.

Under no circumstances may students in the district be allowed to use school athletic equipment and/or facilities unless they are under the direct supervision of a staff member or adult designated by the administration.

Activities on school premises must be appropriate with functions customarily acceptable in the community.

Public dances will not be allowed in school facilities unless the activity is affiliated with the school.

The users shall assume all responsibility and liability for any injury or damage to person or property while they are using the school's facilities.

The Wall School buildings and grounds are designated as drug and alcohol free areas. Events where firearms, weapons, or alcohol are involved will not be allowed or permitted on school property. Smoking is not allowed in any of the school district's buildings, but will be allowed by adults who are not students during public events outside of the gym at the west exit of the main gym lobby and at the football facility.
