CONTESTS

The superintendent or designee must approve distribution of materials to students concerning contests sponsored by non-school organizations.

The superintendent or designee shall consider the following criteria in deciding whether to distribute such materials:

- 1. The age and maturity of the students;
- 2. The relationship of the topic of the contest to the curriculum;
- 3. The extent to which the contest materials encourage entrants to study and present all sides of controversial issues;
- 4. Alternative means available to the contest sponsors, such as the news media, for disseminating contest information.

Teachers may utilize appropriate contest materials for class projects if approved by the building principal.
