

Wall School District / Hall of Fame Constitution

MISSION: The purpose of the Wall School District Hall of Fame shall be to recognize those men and women of the Wall Community who have made outstanding contributions to the Wall School District.

ELIGIBILITY: Any person who has been involved in the Wall School District is eligible for consideration. This includes, but is not limited to, players, coaches, managers, advisors, administrators, teachers, media, or any other person who has had direct involvement in the promotion of, or the running of activities/academic events.

BOARD: The Hall of Fame board shall consist of seven members:

- 1) The current Wall School District principal or designee.
- 2) The current Wall School District activities director or designee.
- 3) Two current members of the Wall School District coaching or advising staff.
- 4) One member of the current Wall School board.
- 5) Two long term community members.

INDUCTEE ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for consideration the person must have been out of high school for 5 years. There shall be no year qualifications for coaches/advisors, contributors, media, etc.

ELECTION: The Board shall accept nominations from anyone. Members may also submit nominations. A form has been adopted and is available. After nominations are received, the Board shall review each one and make their selection(s) from the nominations. Members must be present to vote on any official business. Voting for inductees shall be by secret ballot and require a majority of those present for selection. Nominations will be kept active for five years.

NUMBER OF INDUCTIONS: No more than two inductions will take place during an academic year.

TIME OF INDUCTION: The induction(s) shall take place at Spring Awards Night or Graduation.
